#### a fourth generation family business

In 1918 Samuel Clarke started the company to compassionately support local families and give their loved ones the send-off they deserved. With his wife Minnie, they quickly gained a reputation for treating each family with dignity and respect. The company proudly upholds these foundational values four generations and more than 100 years later.

#### the early years

The young business outgrew its offices and moved to Movilla Street. This provided space for horses and with a spirit of innovation that has remained at the company's core, the town's first motorised hearse in 1929.

Joined by his son John in 1940, further growth lead to the requirement in 1970 for a funeral church. This was built in Court square, the present day location of our Newtownards branch.





#### live streaming pioneers

John and Lyla's son Jim joined the company in 1979 and oversaw the opening of a branch in Bangor in 2004 to better serve families living in North Down.

That year, the company also became the first funeral director in the world to offer live-streaming which enabled families separated by distance or illness to remotely attend the funerals of loved ones.

#### innovating for an eco-friendly future

Johnathan, the 4th generation of the Clarke family to serve the business, oversaw a large investment into greener energy, starting with the installation of 20KW of solar panels across both locations.

The company also introduced the first fully electric ambulance in Northern Ireland and the first plug-in-hybrid electric hearses and a limousine. Now, most of the company's funeral services are powered by the sun.




- 1. Drawn by a pair of Belgian Black horses, with leather harnesses & black plumes. The maximum distance for a horse-drawn hearse is 3 miles. For longer journeys an additional motorised hearse charged at £240 would be required for the start or remainder of the journey.
- 2. Embalming is a technique used to safely preserve your loved one and restore their appearance until the day of the funeral. It is chosen by the majority of families and is *strongly recommended*.
- 3. When embalming is not chosen it is typically for medical or religious reasons, in which case you should discuss the implications with an arranger.
- 4. Not included: a coffin which is selected separately and starts from £410
  - third-party fees such as council fees / florist charges / funeral notices.

# order of service designs


Our order of service designs are printed in full colour on 160gsm folded card to create an A5-sized 4 page document. To achieve an uncluttered layout, we advise only including the hymns on the inside pages. The back is the ideal position for a personal thank you from the family, details of chosen charities and refreshments. There is also space on the back for an additional photograph should that be desired.




**design 1**Circular Photo with Foliage

**design 5**Circular photo with flowers





#### headstones

#### inscriptions

As well as producing new memorials, we add inscriptions to existing memorials. We are here to give guidance on suitable inscription wording and available options. We can match in with existing lettering from a photograph. Contact us for further details.





#### wedges | tablets | vases

An alternative to a headstone, or in addition to an existing one, we have a selection of memorials vases, wedges, tablets and slabs in various stone colours and sizes. They can be inscribed with a short inscription and placed on a grave. We have a range on display at out Newtownards branch. Please contact us for details and prices.

#### repair | refurbish

We refurbish and repair old headstones and white marble particularly can come up like new (as shown in the photograph). Please contact us with a photograph of the existing headstone and the location of the grave for prices and full details.



f.a.q

How soon after burial can I erect a headstone? In the past it was necessary to wait, but now you can proceed as soon as you feel able, as we install a foundation that bridges a recently—opened grave.

<u>How long does it take once I order a headstone / wedge / inscription?</u> We aim to have it completed in 8–10 weeks from ordering for inscriptions and stock items and 20–24 weeks for imported stone.

**How long does council planning take?** Planning can take up to 6 weeks, however this will not affect the completion date.

After the headstone + inscription, is there any other cost? Council cemeteries and some churchyards charge a fee, but we itemise these in the quotation. Fees can be paid to us and we will pass them on.

When do we have to pay? For vases, wedges and inscriptions, we usually ask for payment up-front, but for a headstone, a 50% deposit secures the order, with the balance on completion. Alternatively we can apply for payment from the estate via a solicitor.
